COMMUNITY CONCERNS FROM  
**June 17, 2015**  
BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING  
AND  
RESPONSES BY DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION

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**CONCERN:** A parent shared his frustration with several items involving District and site administration and lack of performance:

- Parent suggestions are not being considered and recommendations made at School Site Council are not being adhered to nor completed.
- There is an expressed lack of concern from administration regarding the gaps/poor achievement of specifically, our African American students in math.
- Lack of openness and honesty regarding student performance and next steps of support.

**RESPONSE:** Site and District Administration have met with the parent throughout the school year, encouraging him and others to participate in numerous school events and advisory councils. Procedures and policies for planning and conduction of school events have been shared and discussed with him as well.

In a recent conversation on June 29, 2015, the parent was encouraged to:

- Continue his active involvement on Heritage High School's School Site Council (SSC)
- Work closely with the new principal in developing strategies for community outreach expansion, review of site performance, and determination of needs and actions (via SSC and other advisory committees).
- Utilize posted LCAP and Annual Update posted on District website as it contains an overview of performance, details goals and objectives, as well as defines actions to achieve such goals.
- Participate on the development and implementation of the District's African American Advisory Council (DAAAC), soon to begin in September 2015.
