COMMUNITY CONCERNS FROM
November 18, 2015
BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING
AND
RESPONSES BY DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION

CONCERN: A Perris High School parent spoke about the concerns he shared with the Board at the October 21st Board Meeting. Again, the parent alleges that the football coaches are "bullying" students during practices.

RESPONSE: The Principal has met with this parent on multiple occasions. The parent's concerns have not been substantiated.

CONCERN: A Heritage High School teacher shared concerns about student and staff safety at Heritage High School. He recommended that the District send more students to the Academy in order to improve school and classroom behavior throughout the District.

RESPONSE: The teacher's perspective runs contrary to the Positive Behavior Intervention Strategies that are being implemented in schools and districts nationwide. District Administration contends that the process to send students to the Academy is a sound due process procedure. Moreover, District Administration is working with Heritage High School Administration on strategies to reduce the number of student-to-student altercations.
