



Chromebook Distribution Form 2018-2019

The new California Common Core State Standards create the opportunity to improve education and address the technology needs of our students. Students need frequent and appropriate access to technology that allows them to learn, analyze, research and create. In order to facilitate this, the Perris Union High School District is implementing a 1:1 initiative, meaning the District will equip each student with a Chromebook, which is a portable computer. This will provide equitable access to learning experiences for all students as they will now have the ability to take their devices to and from school.

Student/Parent Responsibility

Each student will be responsible for the device that has been assigned to them. In the event that the device is lost (stolen, not returned, missing, etc.) the student/parent will be responsible to pay \$325 for the replacement cost of the Chromebook. This is very similar to the existing textbook replacement policy in use at PUHSD and many other school districts.

If the device is damaged and/or inoperable, the student will be responsible for returning the device to the school site for repair and will be charged a \$50 fine for damage repair. A replacement Chromebook will be issued upon return of the damaged device.

Acknowledgement of Responsibility

I acknowledge that I am responsible for the Chromebook unit that has been issued to me/my student. If the unit is lost, I will be charged \$325 for the replacement cost of the Chromebook. If the unit becomes damaged and/or inoperable as a result of negligence, I will return the unit to the school for repair and I will be charged a \$50 fine for damage repair.
