A. To qualify for CSF membership this semester, please follow these guidelines:

- 1. You must earn a minimum of 10 points from last semester's grades.
a. The first 4 points must be from LIST I (unless you are a current senior applying for membership in January 2016).
b. The first 7 points (including the 4 points described in 1.a) must be from LISTS I and II.
c. The remaining points may come from any LIST (I, II or III).
2. You must use no more than 5 courses to qualify.
3. No CSF points are given for any physical education classes, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving office or teacher assisting, ANY summer school or community college courses used for high school credit, any pass/fail courses.
4. CSF points are granted as follows:
Grade of A = 3 CSF points
Grade of B = 1 CSF point
o 1 additional point earned for grade A or B in AP or Honors course only (advanced courses do NOT count)
o Maximum of 2 additional AP or Honors points per semester
Grade of C = 0 CSF points
Grade of D or F in ANY course (even in a class you cannot use to qualify) disqualifies the semester membership

B. Also remember:

- 1. CSF membership is based on work done in the previous semester
2. You must reapply for membership each semester.
3. Courses are divided into LISTS I, II, and III. Please see back of application for detailed information.
4. Application for Spring 2015 membership is due: Friday, August 28, 2015 by 3:30pm to W-114
