Who I am





The Resurrection of Jesus Christ



United Nations secretary-general **Kurt Waldheim** observed Earth Day with similar ceremonies on the March equinox in 1972, and the **United Nations Earth Day** ceremony has continued each year since on the day of the March equinox (the **United Nations** also works with

organizers of the April 22 global event). Margaret Mead added her support for the equinox Earth Day, and in 1978 declared:

"Earth Day is the first holy day which transcends all national borders, yet preserves all geographical integrities, spans mountains and oceans and time belts, and yet brings people all over the world into one resonating accord, is devoted to the preservation of the harmony in nature and yet draws upon the triumphs of technology, the measurement of time, and instantaneous communication through space. Earth Day draws

on astronomical phenomena in a new way – which is also the most ancient way – by using the vernal Equinox, the time when the Sun crosses the equator making the length of night and day equal in all parts of the Earth. To this point in the annual calendar, EARTH DAY attaches no local or divisive set of symbols, no statement of the truth or superiority of one way of life over another. But the

selection of the March Equinox makes planetary observance of a shared event possible, and a flag which shows the Earth, as seen from space, appropriate."





Infamous Birthdays

Adolf Hitler was born in Braunau am inn, Austria on april 20 1889. He died on april 30 1945 in Berlin Germany. He is best known for being the leader of Nazi Germany from 1934 through 1945. He also initiated ww2 and millions of deaths resulted because of him. Him and his wife Eva Braun committed suicide in a bunker. He was the forth out of six children had by his parents Alois Hitler and Klara Polzl. When he was three he moved from Austria to Germany. He started the holocaust. As a

child he frequently clashed with his father. When his younger brother Edmund died in 1900, he became detached and introverted. His father didn't approve of his interest in fine arts instead of business. Hitler also showed an interest in German nationalism, rejecting the authority of Austria-Hungary. Alois died unexpectedly in 1903, two years later his mother let him drop out. He moved to Vienna and become a casual worker and water color painter. He applied to the Academy of Fine

Arts twice and was rejected both times, out of money he moved to a homeless shelter where he lived for several years. At the outbreak of ww1 he applied to serve in the german army and was accepted in august 1914. He was decorated for his bravery as a soldier. He was shocked when Germany surrendered in 1918. He was very patriotic person. After ww1 he returned to Munich and continued to work for the military as an intelligence officer. While he was monitoring the German Workers' Party (DAP), he picked up many anti-semitic, nationalist and anti-Marxist ideas of DAP founder Anton Drexler.


Drexler invited Hitler to join DAP which he did in 1919. In 1921 Hitler replaced Drexler as party chairman. He served a year in prison because on november 8, 1923 Hitler and the SA (Nazi paramilitary organization) stormed a public meeting of 3,000 at a beer hall in Munich where he announced that the national revolution has begun and declared the formation of a new government, after a short struggle this failed and resulted in 20 deaths. During the great depression of Germany he became a strong force in German politics.

Balancing Technology








Brave New world and Fahrenheit 451
