

National Honor Society: Obligations of Membership

Question: What are the NHS obligations for all Heritage High School chapter members?

Answer: The National NHS Constitution and our chapter by-laws delineate 7 formal obligations of membership:

 Induction Ceremony: All members must be inducted at a special inaugural ceremony to become active members of the chapter. A student remains in the condition of being a 'successfully selected candidate' until this ceremony is undertaken. To become a member, all selected candidates <u>must</u> attend this event:

- 2. <u>Donation</u>: New NHS members donate \$15 to the HHS NHS chapter. In exchange, members will receive an HHS National Honor Society wearable.
- 3. <u>Maintaining Standards</u>: Once selected, all active members are expected to maintain the standards by which they were selected: Scholarship, Service, Leadership and Character. Active members not maintaining these standards may be placed on NHS membership probation. If membership is revoked, a student may not be readmitted to the same NHS chapter.
- 4. <u>Meetings</u>: Our chapter holds required monthly General Membership meetings. In addition, chapter officers must meet for a monthly preparation meeting. A member may only miss a maximum of 4 hours before membership probation occurs possibly leads to dismissal. It is possible to make-up meeting credits.
- 5. <u>Collective Service Project</u>: All chapters are required to sponsor at least 1 collective chapter service project and all members are required to participate. Each year, members will determine the collective service project.
- 6. <u>Individual Service Project</u>: In addition to the collective chapter service project, individual members will engage in an independent service project according to their own talents and interests. Upon completion, members will create a poster project that will be displayed publically to promote community service.
- 7. <u>Additional Obligations</u>: It is beneficial for parents and students to understand that NHS membership requires a commitment of time. Each student should be actively working on an NHS Committee and participating in extra NHS events and activities.
